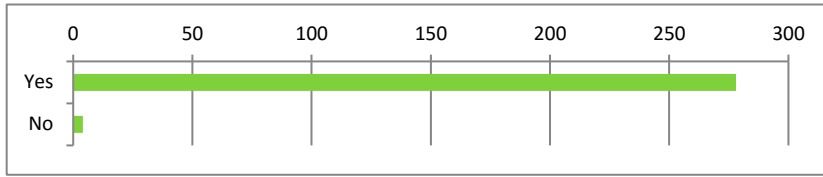
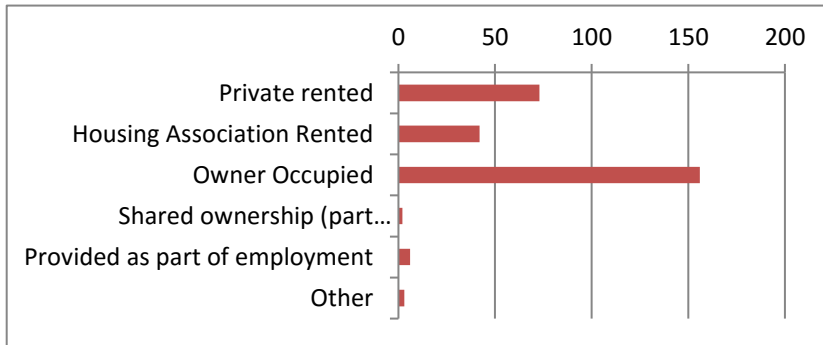

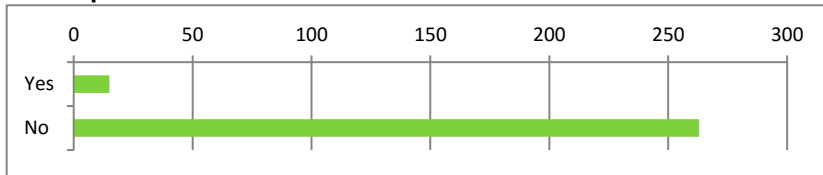
1. Is this dwelling your household's main residence?



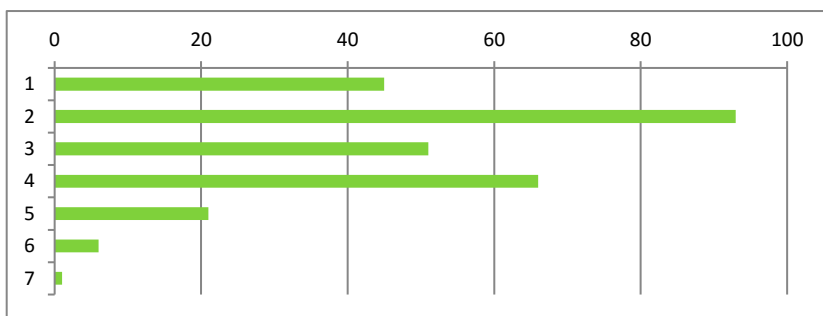

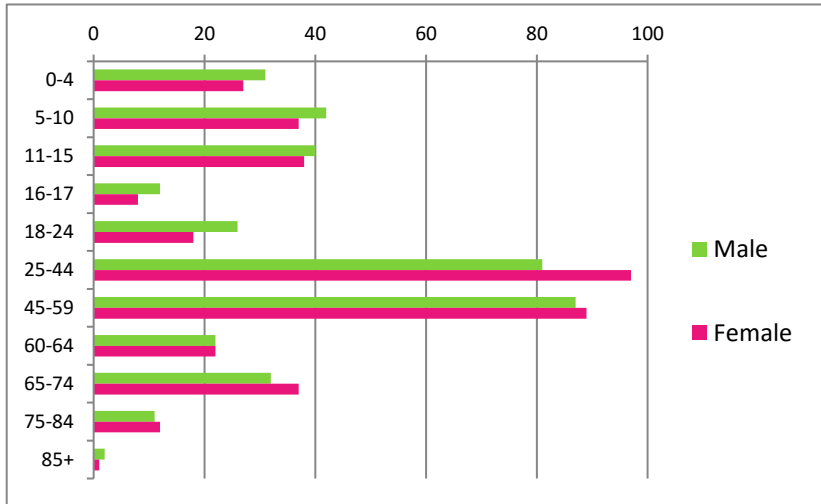

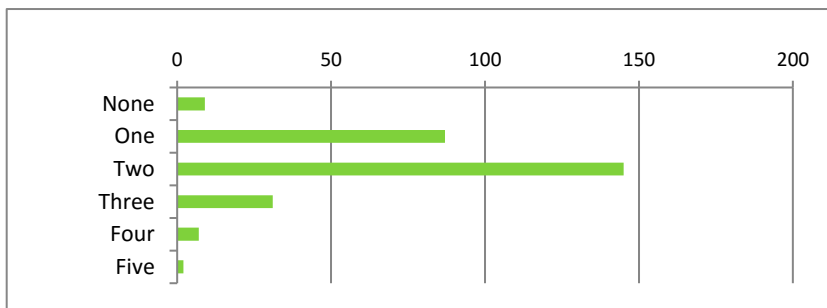
4. How many people normally live in your household?



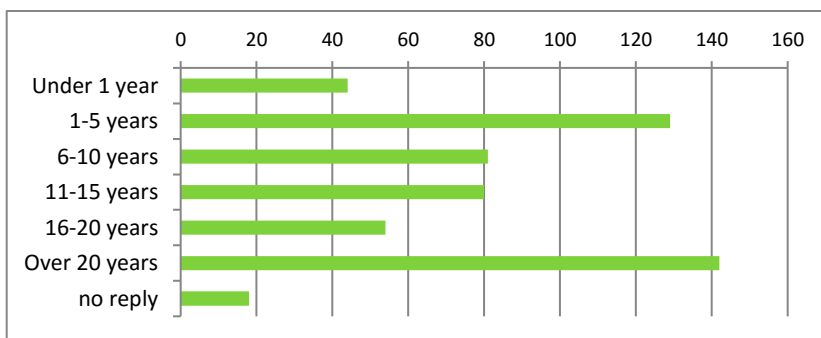
Reported Age structure of HN population



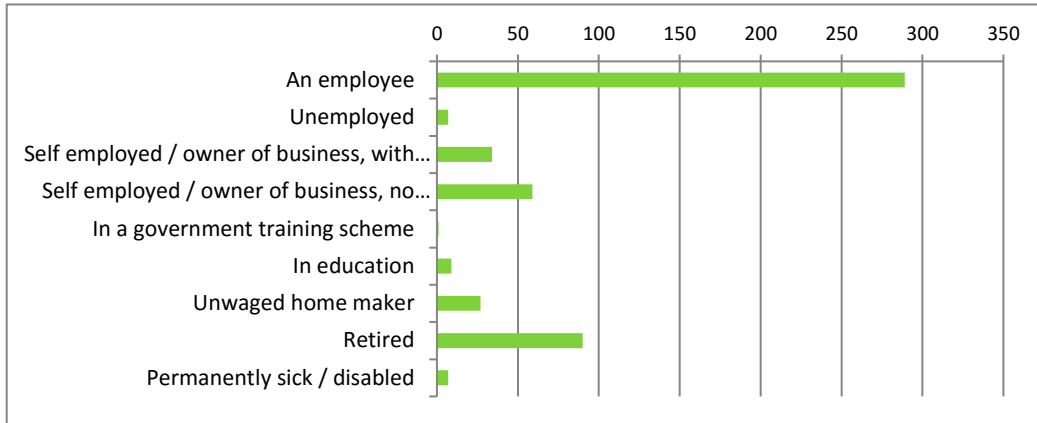

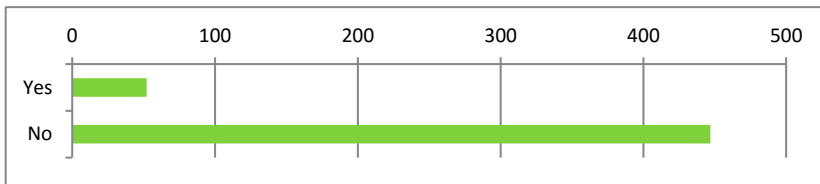
12. Would you like to see cycle-ways to join the following villages? (multiple answers allowed)

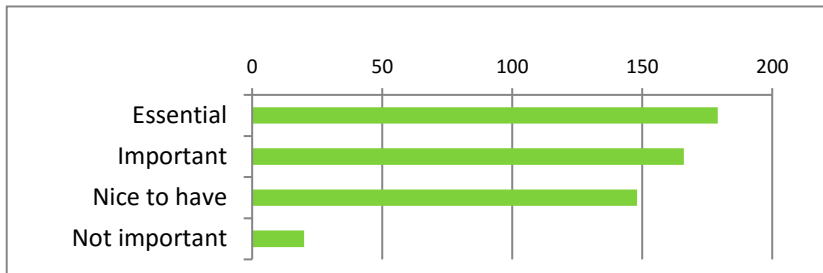
17. HN School: If the number of children in the catchment area increases sufficiently and consistently, would you support an increase in the building's footprint?



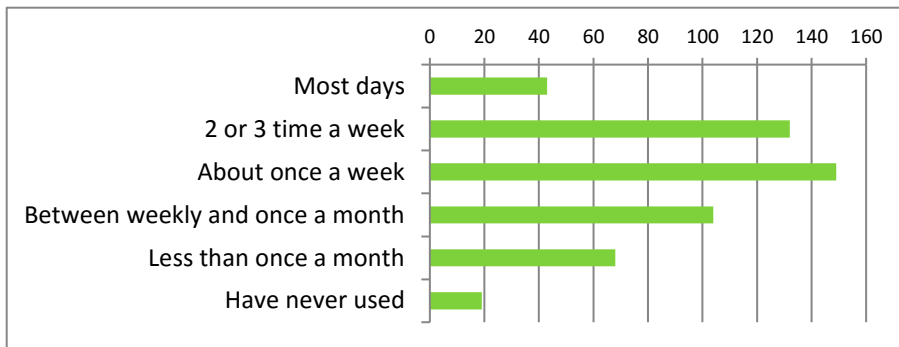

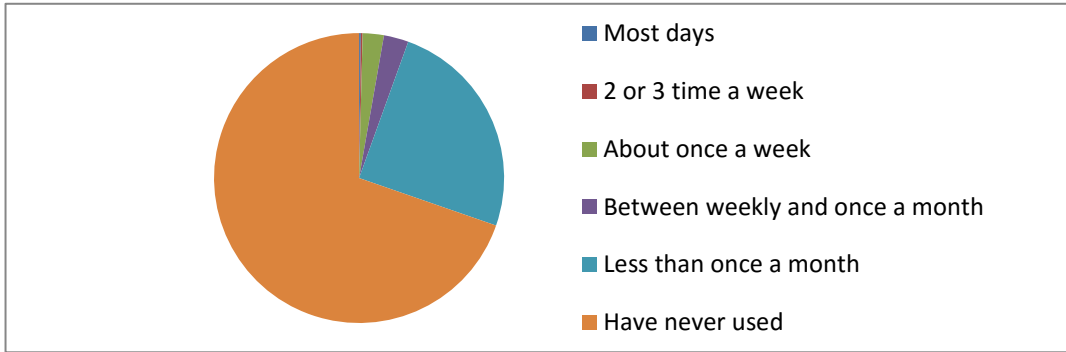
19. On average, how often do you use the HN Community Shop?

21. On average, how often do you use the café facilities in the shop?



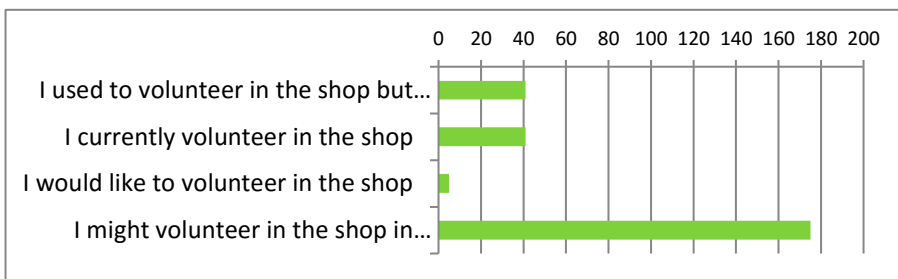

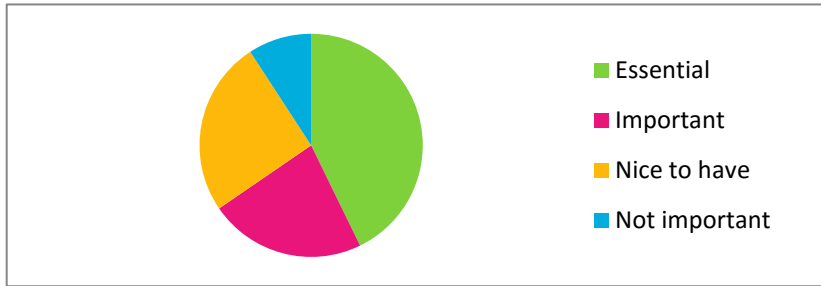

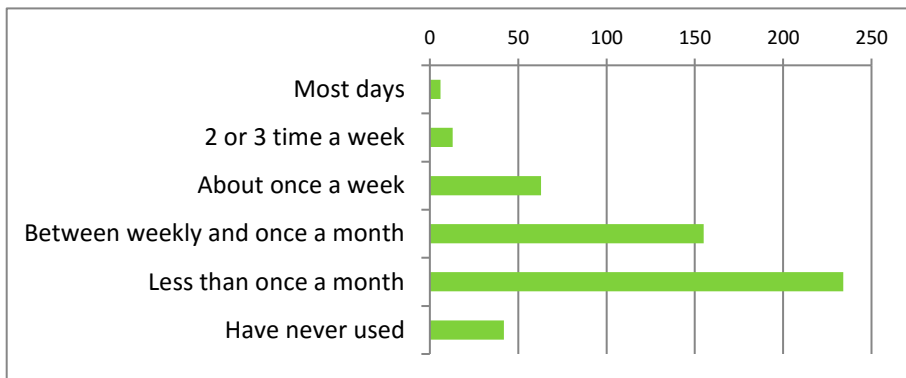

24. How important is the White Hart pub to the HN community?



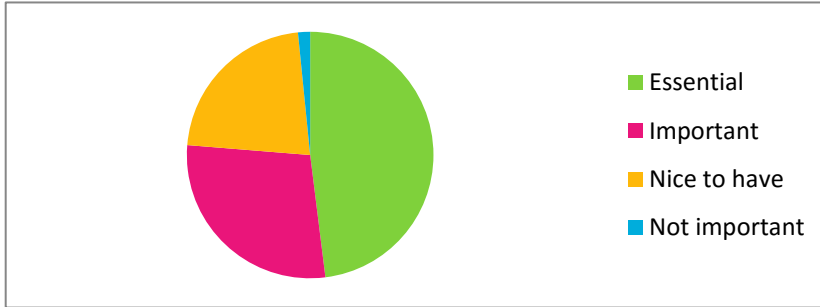

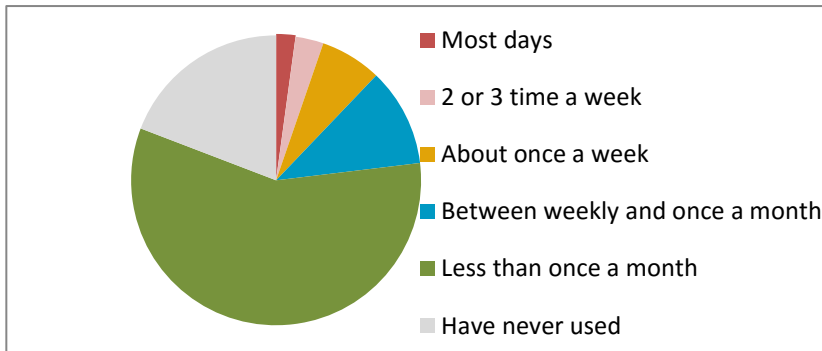

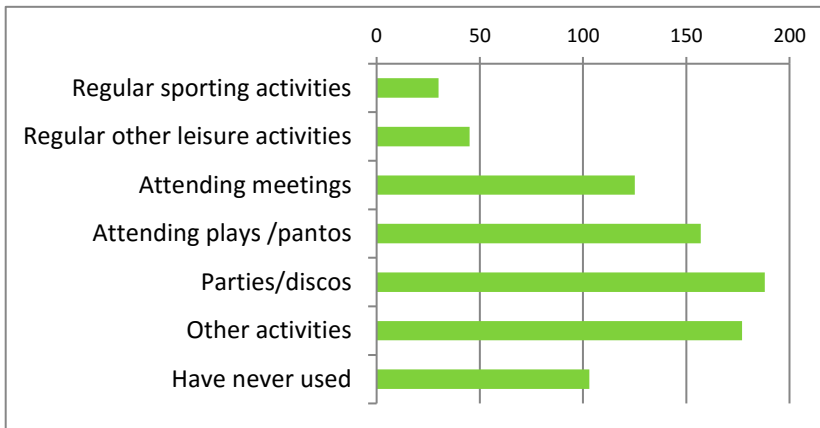
27. How important is the Village Hall to the HN community?



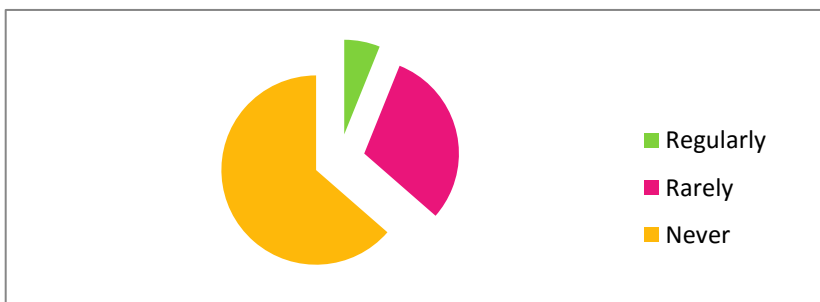
28. How often do you use the Village Hall?

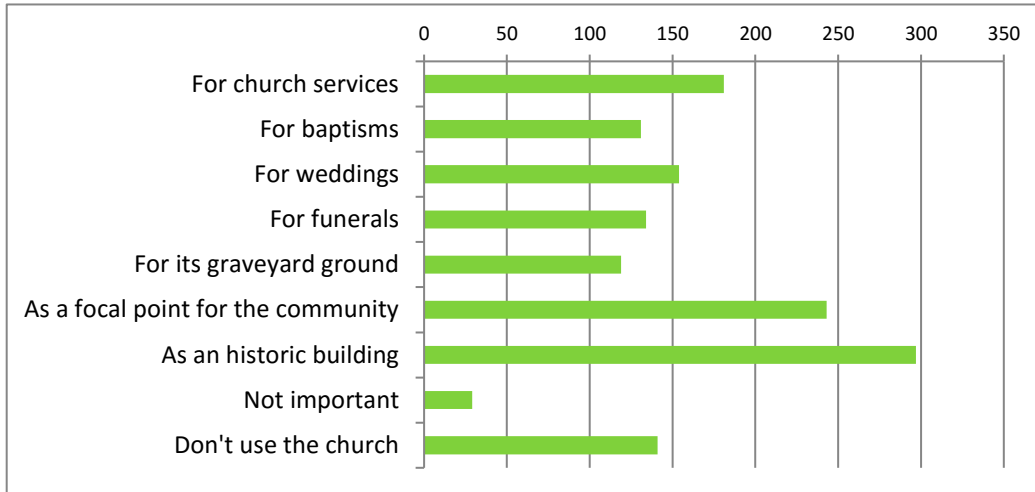

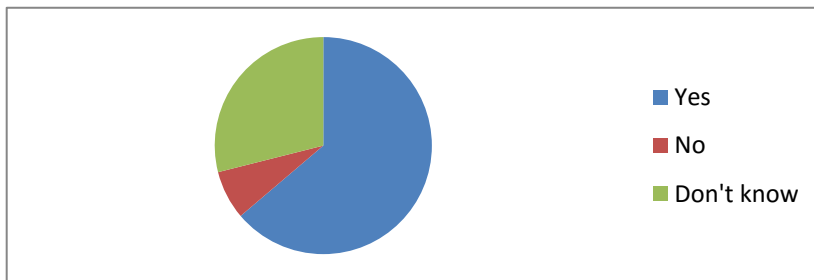

34. Do you agree that it is a good idea for St. Mary's Church to improve hearing, toilet and catering facilities of the church building so that it can be used more for church and community events?

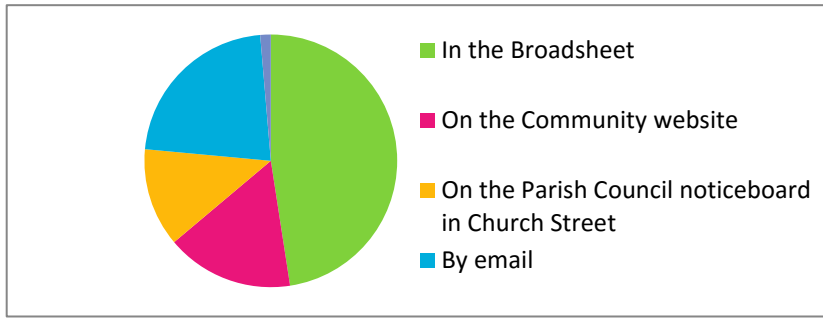

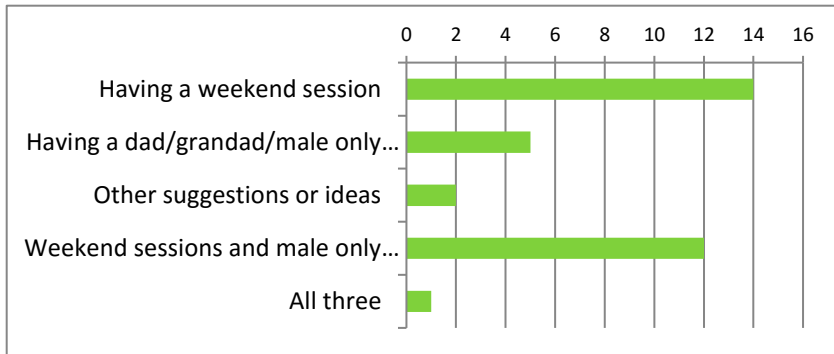

43. For those with children under 5. If you do not attend Chuckles..why?

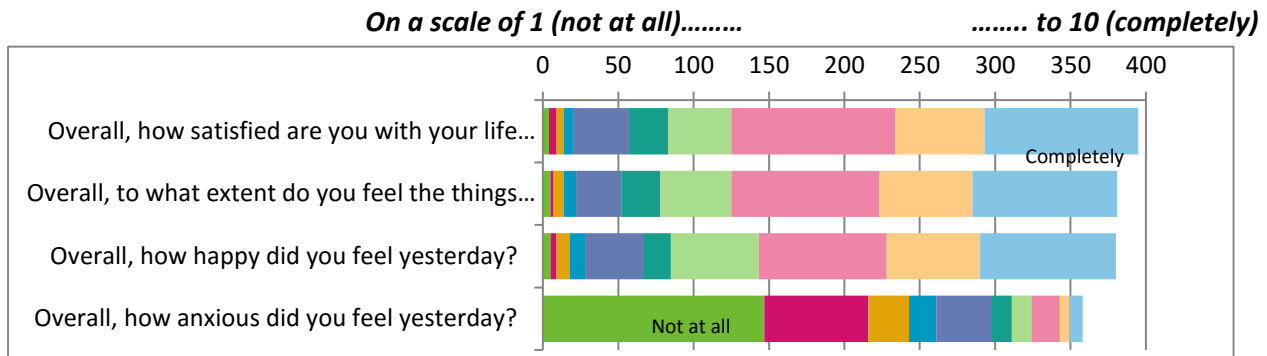


44. For those with children under 5: would you be interested in Chuckles Baby & Toddler Group

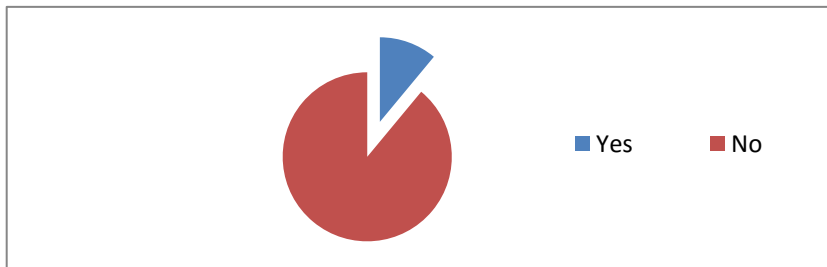

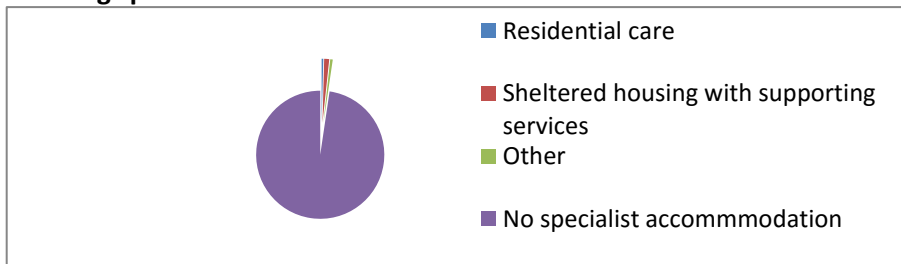

47. Do you have a health problem / disability that affects your day to day living?



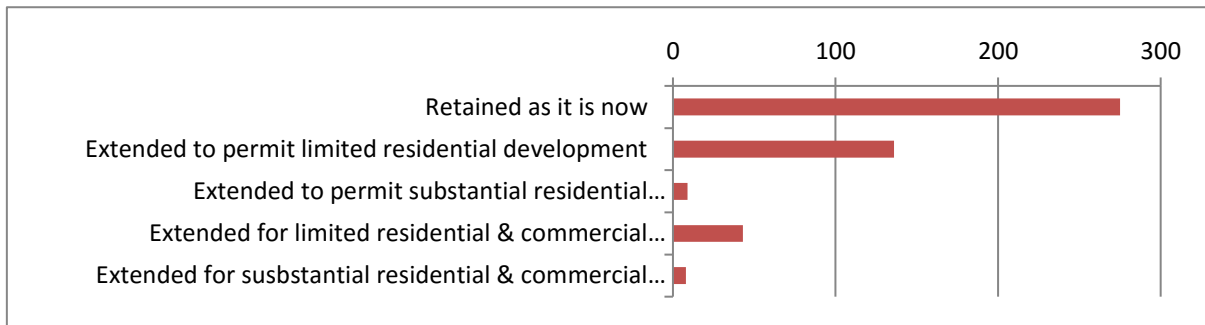

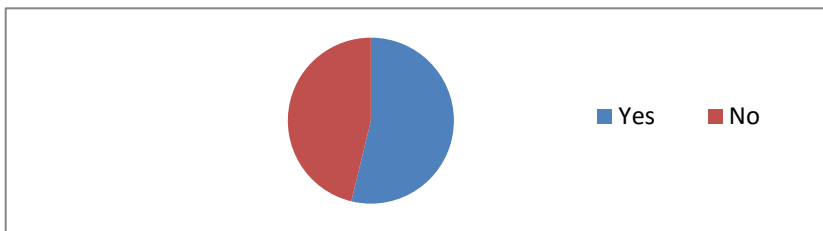
52. Do you have concerns about your or your children's safety when crossing roads in HN?



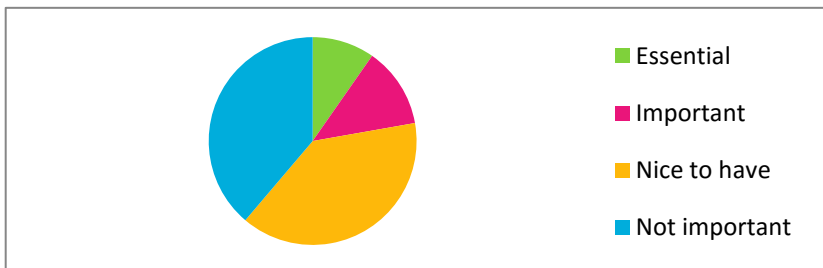
53. Would your concerns about road safety be addressed by the introduction of more traffic calming measures in ? (multiple answers allowed)
